Stonebrooke Owners' Association, Inc. Common Area Guidelines & Rules

STONEBROOKE CLUBHOUSE (7818 S. Indian Ave)

- 1. Booking of the clubhouse is for resident use only. The Stonebrooke resident who reserves the clubhouse must be present for the event.
- 2. Maximum occupancy of the clubhouse is limited to 40 people.
- 3. For reservations, the resident is to refer to the Stonebrooke website:
 <u>www.stonebrooketulsa.com</u> The reservation link is located under the "SERVICES" tab. The following information is required in the request: Resident's Name, Address, Date of Event, hours needed (from and to), purpose, and number of people.
- 4. For keys to the clubhouse, use contact information on the Stonebrooke website. A Reservation Coordinator will manage the reservations and keys.
- 5. Please be conscientious of noise level after dark, out of respect for neighbors nearby the building.
- 6. No tobacco use of any kind allowed in the clubhouse.
- 7. Any damage done to the clubhouse or bathrooms must be reported to a Stonebrooke Owner's Association Board Member. Repairs will be arranged by the association and paid for by the resident who made the reservations.
- **8.** Upon leaving the clubhouse, the resident must follow directions on the "Clubhouse Clean-Up Checklist". Resident will be charged \$100, if the clubhouse is not cleaned according to the "Clubhouse Clean-Up Checklist".

Clubhouse Clean-Up Checklist

- 1. Remove all trashbags.
- 2. Wipe down all surfaces.
- 3. Sweep floor.
- 4. Thermostat should be set at 60 degrees in the winter and 80 degrees in the summer.
- 5. Turn off lights
- 6. Take all personal items.
- 7. Lock doors.
- 8. Return keys to Reservation Coordinator.
- **9.** Violation of these rules may lead to suspension of recreational privileges, as per Article 7, 7.1(b) of the Stonebrooke Owners' Association Bylaws.
